THE LENTEN JOURNEY BEGINS

March 1st is the first Sunday in Lent, the season in which the church prepares itself once again for the observance of Holy Week and celebration of Easter. It is a time for reflection, for confession, and for repentance. All of this is to give deep meaning to what we will claim on Good Friday, “Jesus died for our sins.” To appreciate the wondrous gift of God’s love and grace in Christ requires first a deep acknowledgment of why such a sacrifice was necessary. Some may “give up” something for Lent. Some may “take on” something for Lent. But all should strive to appreciate the atoning work of Jesus in death with a greater depth of appreciation than we have ever experienced before.

In our Sunday morning sermons we are going to look at encounters of Jesus with persons recorded in John’s gospel. In “Meeting Jesus in John” we will focus on these sermon texts in morning worship during March:

March 1 — John 1:1-18 — “And the Word Became Flesh”

March 8 — John 2:1-12 — “The Best Wine”

March 15 — John 3:1-21 — “Born Again to an Enormous Hope”

March 22 — John 4:1-42 — “True Worshipers”

March 29 — John 8:1-11 — “The Sound of Dropping Rocks”




CHILDREN AND YOUTH CHOIRS SINGING IN MARCH
