gaging safely with more people on campus. But at this time, we believe that we should continue the good practices we have followed more than a year. They are:

1. Stay home when you are sick, have symptoms, are waiting for test results, or know you have been directly exposed to COVID-19.
2. Wear your masks to church. Use them as we pass each other in aisles, ways and restrooms and at all times we are not socially distancing. When you are seated and you are more than six feet from another person, mask wearing can then be your preference.
3. Use the hand sanitizer stations when you enter and exit the Sanctuary and classrooms.
4. Socially distance as much as possible. We will have you sitting in other rows in the Sanctuary. Leave a space of six feet on the floor between you/your family and the next worshipers.
5. Understand why we will continue the no contact measures we have been using in worship — offering plates on tables, communion cups, lyrics in the bulletin, no touch exchanges of peace, bulletins on tables, etc.
6. Remember we are doing these things to keep everyone safe and for the comfort of those who choose to worship with us.
