HOLY WEEK

This morning begins Holy Week, the week that commemorates the time from Palm Sunday through the passion of Jesus and concludes with the celebration of Easter. This morning we will enjoy watching our children bring palm branches to the sanctuary as we sing our “hosannas.” Tonight at 6:30 p.m. we will enjoy listening to our Music Mates, Cherub, and Junior choirs sing. After they sing in the sanctuary, they will have an Easter Egg Hunt.

Wednesday night we will have our regular Wednesday night programs. Remember to make your dinner reservation by Monday at 8:00 p.m.

Easter is not complete without a Maundy Thursday service. The service will begin at 7:30 p.m. During the service we will remember the upper room, Gethsemane, the trial, and the crucifixion. At this candlelight communion service you will hear the music of our Sanctuary Choir and soloist, Sheri Hester. This beautiful service will gradually reduce the light until we dismiss in silence and darkness. Nursery will be provided for preschoolers.

Easter Sunday morning you will have two opportunities to worship at ZBC. Our Sunrise service in the courtyard will begin at 7:00 a.m. After the Sunrise service, the Purple Worship Team will provide Bojangles biscuits in the fellowship hall. We will have regular Sunday School on Easter Sunday. We hope that you will join us in the sanctuary on Easter morning at 10:15 a.m. for worship.
