NEW HAPPENINGS IN THE NURSERY

It is our utmost desire to make sure all children that come to our nursery (Infants-3 & 4-year olds) are safe, well cared for, and loved. To ensure this continues, a few practices are being put into place. In the next few weeks, you will see Ms. Susan outside of the glassed-in nursery area with a rolling cart. We are asking ALL children in the Nursery, which includes Infants through 3 & 4-year old class, to be signed in with Ms. Susan and get a nametag before being dropped off in their class. At class drop-off, there will be a teacher in their room to greet them. This will be the drop-off process for Sunday School and for Worship should you only be coming for worship. At pick-up, please stop by and see Ms. Susan and sign your child out before going to get them from their room.

We realize this will cause some delay in parents getting to their Sunday School classes or worship a few minutes later, and we also realize the first few weeks will be a little chaotic. After you have filled out all of your child’s information on the check-in/-out sheet once, it will already be printed, and all you have to do is initial the check-in/-out box.
