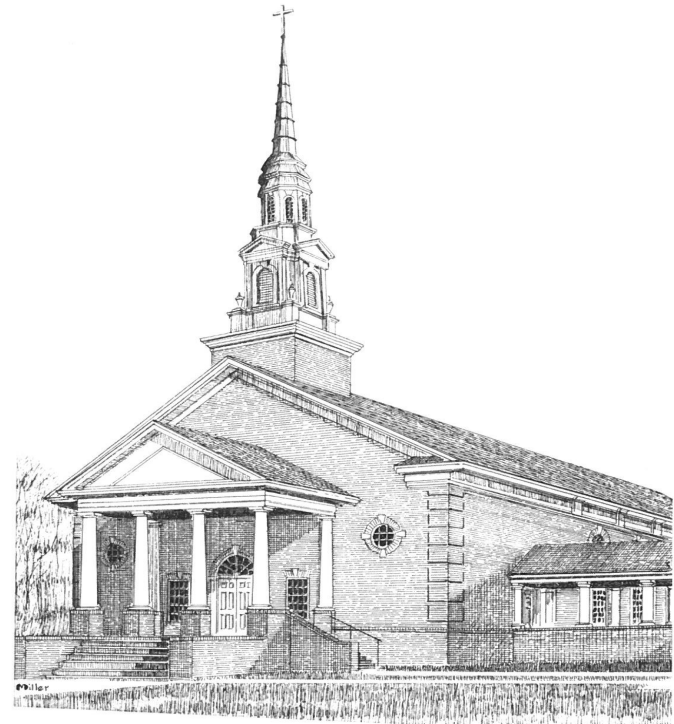

NEW HAPPENINGS IN THE NURSERY

We are so excited to see our nursery numbers back to where they were pre-Covid. It is our utmost desire to make sure all children that come to our nursery (infants to 3- and 4-year olds) are safe, well cared for, and loved. To ensure this continues, a few practices are being put into place. Beginning today, September 4, you will see Ms. Susan Richert will be stationed outside of the glassed-in nursery area with a rolling cart. ALL children in the nursery area (infants through 3- and 4-year old class) must be signed in with Ms. Susan and get a name tag before being dropped off in their classroom. At class drop-off, there will be a teacher in their room to greet them. This will be the drop-off process for Sunday School and for worship should you only be coming for worship. At pick-up, please stop by and see Ms. Susan and sign your child out before going to get them from their room. We realize this will cause some delay in parents getting to their Sunday School classes or worship a few minutes later, and we also realize the first few weeks will be a little chaotic. We appreciate your patience for the first few weeks as we put this new system in place. After you have filled out all of your child's information on the check-in/check-out sheet once, it will be printed for the following weeks, and all you must do is initial the check-in/check-out box. By working together, we can ensure that all of our children remain safe, well cared for, and loved here at Zebulon Baptist Church. Prices are \$10 per adult and \$4 per child. Please pay for dinner with cash (PREFERRED) or checks made payable to "CASH."

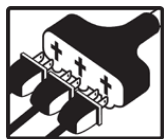
