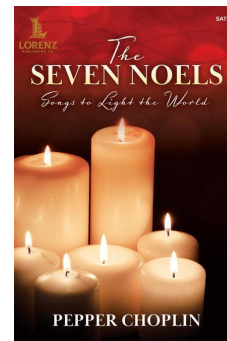

Please note that there will be no regular Wednesday night activities on Wednesday, November 23, as our families will be enjoying Thanksgiving activities.

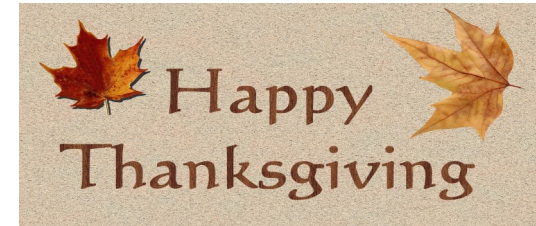
YOUTH NEWS
