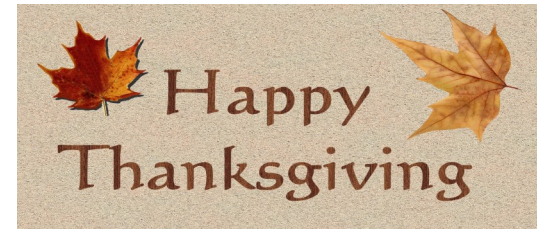

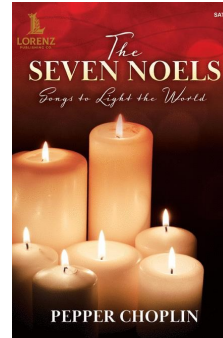
YOUTH NEWS
