Zebulon Baptist Church Family, as we start 2023 off, we also start off the second year of the New Day Capital Campaign. We tend to look back on times when we are starting something new. So, lets do that—Year One of the New Day Capital Campaign was focused on our new Sanctuary windows as our project as well as funding Mission Ventures and Caring for the Campus. As you think back, we as a church also increased our giving to the Mission Ventures and Caring for the Campus funds so that our church could increase our ministry inward and outward as well as continue to insure our ability to maintain our facilities. Year one was a success when you consider those elements; money was given and we did install the new windows and money is available to transfer into our two largest designated funds. The capital campaign committee is so thankful for your stewardship and prayers for our church as we move forward into this new year. We were at 94 percent of our Year One goal, and 23.4 percent of our overall campaign goal.

We as a church will, as always, continue to focus on our primary goals of our capital campaigns—ensuring funds for our Mission Ventures and Caring for the Campus funds, as well as taking direction from the Administrative Deacons and you, the church body, for specific needs such as a new van, updated sanctuary sound and lighting, updated Education Building bathrooms, a new public sign, and other needs as you approve. Year Two started off with a celebration of another \$100,000 being surpassed as we crested over \$200,000. We want to encourage all of our ZBC family, friends and visitors to prayerfully consider giving to the New Day Capital Campaign. We want to exceed our two-year goal of \$425,000! We know we can do this with everyone praying and discerning what each of us will give to ZBC.

Lastly, we want all of us to consider all of the activities in which our church body takes part. A large part of our missional work outward to the community as well as our inward actions of care for our members comes from the Mission Ventures funds. You as a church trust our congregational and program deacons to actively engage with our community and our CBF partners with funding of projects and events here in Zebulon and around the world. We want everyone to look around while they are at our church and think about all that we have been blessed with, and why it is important to be good, prepared stewards of our facilities. Our giving to the capital campaign allows our church the ability to respond when needs arise through the Caring for the Campus funds so that our unified budget doesn't suffer from a large unexpected expenditure. Let us continue to move forward in our giving and our outreach in God’s name here at Zebulon Baptist.
