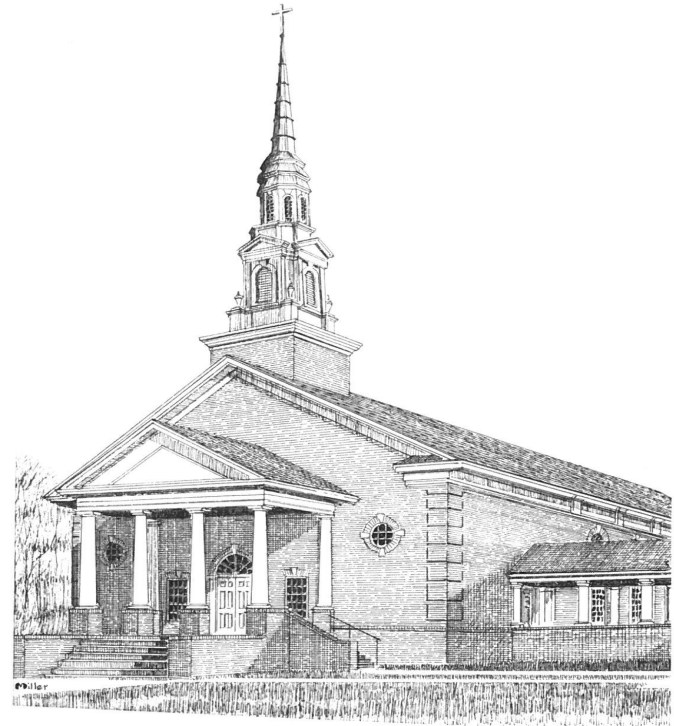

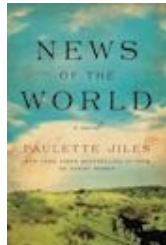


SPIRITUAL FORMATION MINISTRY
