## **JANUARY 2024**

Happy New Year, and welcome to 2024!

In our liturgical calendar we say, "until next time," to the Christmas season, and "Welcome!" to the season after Epiphany, or Epiphanytide. Epiphany comes from the combination of the Greek words *epi and phainein. Phainein means "to appear," or "to shine." Epi is a preposition meaning "upon." Together they might refer to a great manifestation, a surprise unveiling, or even a new revelation.* 

This year the season of Epiphany will lead us to an early Lent. In our worship services between Epiphany (January 6) and Ash Wednesday (humorously, February 14), we're going to be continuing one of the major themes that we contemplated during our Advent season: the gift of Good News. Specifically, we will focus on the ministry of encouragement, which is the hopeful result of hearing the Good News, as well as sharing it. Take a look at our schedule of upcoming services:
