We hope you will join us as your schedule allows for a time of Bible study, discussion, and fellowship.

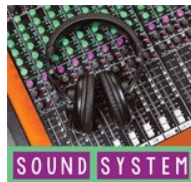


OUR CHRISTIAN SYMPATHY
